Maison Dampt, Bougros 2013 Chablis Grand Cru

Fermented in three-year-old barrels, showing in a delicate mealy character. Delicate lemon citrus. Fine balance between intensity and freshness, the one enhancing the other. Very long. Classy and good value. Drink 2018-2025

Dom Daniel Dampt, Côte de Léchet Premier Cru 2013 Chablis

More dusty/chalky on the nose than the Lys but still clean-cut with citrus fruit plus a little more intensity on the palate. Creamy lees texture increases the depth and pleasure. Good value Drink 2017-2023

Dom Daniel Dampt, Fourchaume Premier Cru 2013 Chablis

This smells particularly stony and less fruity than the Côte de Léchet. Fruit comes through on the palate but this is very crisp and less rich in the middle than the Léchet. Dry, lovely leesy texture and great length. More length than breadth. Good value. Drink 2017-2023

Dom Daniel Dampt, Les Lys Premier Cru 2013 Chablis

Citrus clarity, green-apple freshness. Both clean-cut and creamy with a really nice finely grainy texture. Very good depth and length. Good value. Drink 2016-2020

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
